

Cloudy Water Treatment

Clears cloudy water

EcoPond Cloudy Water Treatment is a natural flocculant, based on a tree bark extract, which will clear green or cloudy pond water. It will cause algae and fine suspended solids to fall to the bottom of the pond leaving the water clean and clear. It is ideal for the treatment of “new pond syndrome” which is generally caused by tiny particles of suspended solids dispersed through the water. It will not harm fish, wildlife or plants within the pond.



Benefits of Cloudy Water Treatment:

- A safe and natural solution for clearing green or cloudy water
- Aids filtration and makes water safer for fish*
- Used in conjunction with EcoPond Mud Muncher it reduces the need to manually clean ponds without filtration systems
- Clean, simple and easy to use.
- Safe for fish, plants, humans, pets and wildlife.

Dosage: 10 ml per 250 litres (55 gallons)

No herbicides or pesticides are used in the manufacture of EcoPond Cloudy Water Treatment. The product does not contain poly acrylamides, or aluminium.

Additional information:

- * Suspended solids in pond water can cause damage to the gills of fish leading to infection and, in severe cases, to fish death.
- Unusually for a natural product Cloudy Water Treatment works quickly with results often seen after just a few hours
- In severe cases repeat dosing may be necessary. Allow 5 days before re-dosing.
- Finely dispersed solids may initially float to the surface after dosing. If left they will quickly drop to the bottom of the pond.

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Frequently Asked Questions:

How do I use Cloudy Water Treatment?

Shake the bottle well and then add to a bucket 10 ml of product for every 250 litres of water to be treated. Mix well and pour evenly over pond surface. In severe cases, repeat dosing may be necessary. Allow 5 days before re-dosing to allow stabilisation following partial success of the initial dose. The dosage chamber on the 250 ml bottle makes it very easy to measure the quantity required. To fill the dosing chamber, remove the cap and squeeze the bottle gently until the required amount has entered the chamber.

In some instances the addition of Cloudy Water Treatment may cause the finely dispersed suspended solids to initially float to the surface. If left, they will soon drop to the bottom of the pond.

How much do I need?

One 250 ml bottle will treat up to 4,500 litres (1000 gallons) of pond water.

What are the benefits of using Ecopond Cloudy Water Treatment?

- It is effective not only against dispersed solids but also against most types of green water algae.
- It produces clear water, enabling full enjoyment of the pond.
- It prevents the accumulation of solid particles on fish gills which can otherwise damage fish health.
- Unlike some flocculants, Ecopond Cloudy Water Treatment is harmless to aquatic and plant life.

Is there anything that stops Cloudy Water Treatment from working?

Cloudy Water Treatment works well under most conditions, but you may require a higher dose in ponds with a high silt content. This is because silt is less likely to clump together and will absorb some of the activity of the product.

Is there a situation where it cannot be used?

No, it is safe to use in even the most sensitive environments.

What happens if I add too much?

Overdosing may actually worsen the problem. It is better to apply a repeat dose after a 5 day interval than to increase the initial dose.

What happens to the solids when they fall to the bottom of the pond?

Normally they would slowly break down through natural biodegradation. However, if you wish to remove them more quickly you can accelerate their breakdown by using a sludge digester such as Ecopond Mud Muncher.
