Frequently Asked Questions:

What is Ice Free for Bird Baths?

Ecopond Ice Free for Bird Baths is an eco-friendly product based on plant extracts.

What does Ice Free for Bird Baths do?

It lowers the freezing point of water to around -4°C.

How do I use it?

Simply add to the water in your bird bath, following the dosing instructions on the label.

What are the benefits of using Ice Free for Bird Baths?

Ice Free for Bird Baths provides a simple, safe and economic way to prevent water in bird baths from freezing, rather than having to find ways to thaw or remove ice once it has formed. Birds therefore have access to clean water for drinking and bathing.

Is there anything that stops Ice Free for Bird Baths from working?

No, other than extremely cold temperatures - Ice Free will work in temperatures as low as -4°C. However, in areas where the water is particularly soft it may be necessary to increase the dose rate.

Is it totally safe for birds?

Yes, Ice Free for Bird Baths contains only naturally occurring constituents which are widely used in the treatment of ponds and water features. It does not contain glycerol or glycols which are poisonous to birds, or sugars which could create metabolic problems. Neither does it have any deleterious effect on birds' plumage.

Is there a situation where it cannot be used?

No, it is safe to use in even the most sensitive environments.

How much do I need?

For bird baths containing up to 2.5 litres of water, dose 30ml whenever water is added. For larger volumes an additional 10 ml should be added per litre of water.

How do I dose it into my bird bath?

It is supplied in a bottle with a measure on it, so it is easy to apply the required dose. Simply pour directly into the water in the bird bath.

What happens if I add too much?

Don't worry. It is a totally natural product and no harm can be done by adding too much.
